GOLF - Topeka Country Club (Private club - South of city, West of Topeka Avenue.) Dues \$5.50 per month; includes full privilege for families, no extra green's fees; Club has swimming pool, attended; Dining and bi-monthly dances.

Shawnee Country Club (Private Club - 31st & Maryland.) Dues \$3.33 per month, includes free privilege for families, no extra green's fees. Swimming pool. Dining.

White Lakes Club (Public fee course - South of City, East of Highway 75.) Rates 35¢ per day. Clubs rented - 35¢.

SWIMMING - Shawnee Lake and Park located two miles east of the suburb of Highland Park. Complete bathing facilities. Boats rented for fishing. Picnic Tables, 4 Softball fields, Horseshoe courts and Bridle path.

Gage Park on West 10th. One of the largest and best equipped pools in the Middle West. Also tables for picnics; a 300 seat cafe for diners
